With that, I would ask the body to accept this amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. We will now vote on this portion of the Hartnett amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted?

SENATOR HALL: I would like a call of the house and a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have a request for a call of the house. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. Would the senators please check in, the house is under call. Senator Beutler, Senator Morrissey, Senator Chambers, please check in. Senator Chizek, Senator Robinson, Senator Schmit. Senator Wesely, Senator Kristensen, Senator Labedz. We're looking for Senator Kristensen. Senator Kristensen is here. We will proceed with roll call vote on Sections 12 through 14 of the Hartnett amendment to the committee amendments. And since we are at General File, a simple majority is needed. Please proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1846-47 of the Legislative Journal.) 15 ayes, 21 nays.

PRESIDENT MOUL: This portion of the amendment fails. I will raise the call. Senator Hartnett, we'll proceed with the second portion of the amendment.
