

that we have two subjects, not just whether one is related to another for the purpose of our rule but there are really two subjects here. And when you do as Senator Beutler mentioned, talk about the issuing of bonds, and I'm looking at the power to levy taxes, there are two subjects that, to me, are incompatible. They exclude each other and we have, in my opinion, two subjects in the bill. So the Chair is absolutely, positively, unequivocally correct. I just wish that other issues were as clear cut as this one appears to be so that when we deal with germaneness we could resolve them in the way that I suspect that we'll resolve this one. Senator Wickersham, once again, you will meet a fate that I have met so many times during my 22 years that when it's not happening to me, I feel like something is wrong. (Laughter.)

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Just very briefly and not, hopefully, to be terribly repetitive about this, but both bills do, indeed, concern economic development. And if that is not an attachment, if that is not a rationale for bringing them together, we have clearly, we have clearly struck out far beyond that kind of a nexus with other attempts to overrule the Chair and I think it is perfectly valid that we should address this amendment to 1240. Thank you.
