SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: (Microphone not activated immediately.) ...Legislative Chamber. With us as chaplain today we have Pastor Don Gangler, Director of Communications for the United Methodist Headquarters of the Nebraska Conference. Pastor Gangler.

PASTOR GANGLER: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Pastor Gangler. I now call to order the fifty-third day of the Ninety-Second Legislature, Second Session. Roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: Mr. President, new A bill, LB 1237A, by Senator Wickersham. (Read by title for the first time.)
