LB 245A, 1006

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. Speaker, members. This is the amendment that just adds the E clause to the provision dealing with the worker's comp court. I move for adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Discussion, Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. I rise only to support the addition of this amendment. We were a little bit under the impression Tuesday that this matter was covered by the language in the bill, and found afterwards that it was necessary to add this in addition. So I would support the addition of the emergency clause.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Any other discussion on the amendment? Seeing none, closing has been waived. We will now vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Select File amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Senator Wesely, would you like to readvance the bill.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. Speaker, I move to readvance LB 1006.
