until late last evening, and that is a substantive law change, as I argued, it probably should have never been in there, for one. Two, it certainly...we probably should have...well, we certainly should have caught it in the ensuing months, but we did not until late last night. The only way to make this a clean appropriation bill is to take that substantive law change out of LB 1022, and that is what my amendment does, it takes it out of the title of the bill on page 2, and it takes it out of the repealer section of the bill on the final pages of the bill. And so that's what it does is simply...this amendment simply repeals the repealer statute which was a substantive law change, which was originally in LB 1022. And with that, I'd ask for the body's forgiveness for our error and their cooperation in correcting it and getting the bill amended so we can read the bill on Monday morning.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Moore. On the motion to return, any discussion? Seeing none, do you wish to close, Senator Moore? Waives closing. We'll now vote on the motion to return LB 1022. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: The bill is returned. Senator Moore on the amendment.

SENATOR MOORE: I just move the amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion of the amendment? Seeing none, we will vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Senator Will, would you like to readvance the bill.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move for the readvancement of LB 1022 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 1022. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. We'll
