SENATOR MOORE: I'm not arguing that point, like I said, I'm just trying to understand the bill. But it would come under the \$270 million portion. Do you have even a ball park estimate at how much this amendment will decrease the \$270 million?

SENATOR LAMB: I don't have that. Senator...I don't know if Senator Withem has that or not.

SENATOR MOORE: Does Senator Schrock have? Okay, well, then that answers my question with an unknown answer. That's all I have, Mr. Speaker.
