SENATOR LABEDZ: Yes.

SENATOR BOHLKE: I just wanted to...

SENATOR WARNER: One minute.

SENATOR BOHLKE: ...say one more time that what I was doing earlier when I was asking you is I wanted to end it with an invitation to you to lead the way to a new direction in your final days of this Legislature to bring the sides who have been railing against each other, let's end it. Let's concentrate on helping those young women or any women of any age who have unwanted pregnancies. Let's understand it. You would be the perfect person, Senator Labeledz, to lead the way, and it would be a great trademark that you would leave on us.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Ardyce, what I've done, I talked to Senator Hillman before we took the vote and said I would agree with what her amendment stated. And I also agree with Senator Rasmussen's amendment, but I disagree with the fact that they're putting it on LB 78 which strikes...I mean, Senator Bernard-Stevens' amendment...

SENATOR WARNER: Time.

SENATOR LABEDZ: ...that strikes all sections of LB 78. Separately, if they had introduced this as an amendment to the bill without striking all sections of LB 78, I will support both. And I...

SENATOR WARNER: Time.

SENATOR LABEDZ: ...truly appreciate the fact that Senator Rasmussen came up with this. I approve of this also but not to Senator Bernard-Stevens' amendment.
