

SENATOR MORRISSEY: ...they're so ignorant of their thinking and their bias way of thinking that even if women are around they talk that way. I don't always speak out when I should to tell them you're putting the woman in a second class compared to a man, you're lowering their value, their intelligence. And by not speaking out when I should, I'm allowing it to continue. But the feeling is really so strong out there in some areas, and not just this state, the whole country, that it's really sad that that thinking still goes on. And we can condition ourselves to speak properly and say the proper words, as in persons, as opposed to men. But we haven't really overcome that.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Time.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: And that's why I oppose this bill, because we've got a long way to go in that area, and that's what I see this bill as, treating women as second class, inferior people.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Morrissey. Senator Labeledz, followed by Senators Schimek, Bernard-Stevens, Crosby, Rasmussen, Bohlke, Landis, Chambers, and Morrissey. Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Madam Speaker. A question was just asked by Senator Carson Rogers of Senator Landis, what happens to the body of the child at the abortion clinic. And I don't have it right in front of me, but I would have liked to have read you the article that appeared in one of the newspapers where in Omaha a plumber was called to one of the abortion clinics to do something about the clogged up plumbing, and when he got there he refused to work any further because the garbage disposal was completely clogged with little arms and little legs that were put into the garbage disposal. And I also have pictures at home and, I believe, in my office that I would be glad to show you some day where in some of the abortion clinics in Omaha the unborn...the aborted child was put in a plastic bag and put in the garbage can. And we have garbage men that pick up the garbage in Omaha that will verify that. At the abortion clinic they actually...and if I was going to be here next year, that was going to be one of my next bills, to force the abortion clinics to bury the aborted child. And I want to go on further on this amendment of Senator Lindsay's and Senator Landis's, I believe. And I did speak to Senator Hillman when her amendment
