CLERK: (Read LB 1268 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1268, with the emergency clause attached, pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1949 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 8 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 1268, with the emergency clause attached, passes. We'll now go to LB 1292E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1292 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1292, with the emergency clause attached, pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1949-50 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 42 ayes, 0 nays, 7 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 1292, with the emergency clause attached, passes. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and engrossed LB 245A and find the same correctly engrossed; LB 447A, LB 1006, LB 1006A, LB 1241A all reported correctly engrossed. (See pages 1950-51 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 1022, LB 1268, and LB 1292. Mr. Clerk, Select File, LB 719A.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 719A was considered by the Legislature on Friday. At that time Senators Warner and Withem had an amendment pending, AM3834, found on page 1759 of the Journal. I do have amendments to 3834.
