Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. President, I'd like to move to advance the bill. When the new fiscal note comes in, this will be sharply reduced, but we do need to advance it to keep up with the bill. Move for advancement.

SENATOR CONWAY: Is there any discussion on the advancement of LB 431A? I see no lights. Senator Wesely, do you have closing? He waives closing. The question is the advancement of LB 431A to E & R Initial. All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Mr. Clerk, do you want to record?

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 431A.

SENATOR CONWAY: LB 431A is advanced. Any messages on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do, thank you. A new resolution, LR 429. (Read brief explanation.) Amendments to be printed to LB 1240A by Senator Hall. That is all that I have, Mr. President. (See pages 1989-92 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We will move on to LB 1192, Senator Lindsay. Senator Lindsay, would you like to open on LB 1192?

CLERK: Mr. President, 1192 was a bill introduced by Senator Lindsay and a number of members. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 21 of this year. At that time, it was referred to the Revenue Committee, advanced to General File. I have committee amendments pending by the Revenue Committee. (See AM3014 on page 989 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CONWAY: Senator Lindsay, please. Whoops, excuse me, Senator Hall for the committee amendments.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Conway, members. The committee amendments to LB 1192 strike the bill in its entirety, they then become the bill. They did not strike the intent of the legislation though. They do become the bill. It is a total rewrite. Section 1 of the committee amendments basically names the Homeless Shelter Assistance Trust Fund that would be established. Section 2 of the committee amendments introduces a
