SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...not "shall".

SENATOR LINDSAY: ...permissive, it is not mandatory.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I would assume that it is going to be very helpful for a county to be computerized before this would really work if you were going to consolidate within one office.
