

thought that it would make sense to apply it to all counties under a "may" proposition. So with that in the bill when we voted it out, I think it set all of our minds at ease, and there are some counties that are already in that mode because of the proximity of everybody in one office, rather than three offices. So I think this would help all counties if they want to use it, and if they don't want to use it, it is not mandatory. So I would support the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Senator Beyer. Senator Kristensen, it would be your turn again.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Mr. President, excuse me, and members, as Senator Lindsay, as were were discussing, we have had a chance to go through the amendment to check it. I would call your attention, I don't know if anybody else has a copy of this, but if you look at page 19, lines 12 through 20, there happens to be a \$4 fee on each certificate of title for the replacement or duplicates. That I do not believe was in the original LB 1050, and I was wondering why that provision is in there, and if that is a difference, and from my reading, that is definitely a difference from the way 12 or from LB 1050 was drafted earlier.

SENATOR LINDSAY: I don't know, Senator Kristensen. We asked bill drafters to draft this bill to this amendment, and I am trying to think, does the bill, does LB 1092, itself, adjust the fees?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes, Senator Lindsay, that is the major emphasis of the bill.

SENATOR LINDSAY: And I am wondering, does the original Section 2 of the committee amendments describe that additional fee? I don't know, I am looking like you are trying to figure out why this...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Well, I guess that goes back to what I just...I need some time if we are going to do that just to make sure that you don't inadvertently raise some fees that we didn't intend to do or do...not being critical, but I just...when you come to this point, Senator Hall, we will get to your amendments next, and I guess, Senator Lindsay, until I get some time here, or maybe you can explain that to me. I will give you the rest of my time to take a look at that.
