SENATOR LINDSAY: I won't take the rest of that time. I have got my light back on, and I will try to talk on that. I will try to find and see if it...I believe it came from the original bill, but I am going to double check that. I mean not from the original LB 1050, this is just...sometimes I don't know why they come down this direction, this is not the intent. If that is the case, if it is not explained as through the bill, then I will withdraw the amendment. I will take a look at that first.

SENATOR CONWAY: Senator Lindsay, there are no other lights. Do you have any direction for the Chair?

SENATOR LINDSAY: I do have the answer here, Senator Kristensen. It does...that is what the original bill does. That is the fee that you are increasing or that Senator Schellpeper is increasing. The committee amendments strike original Section 2 of the Standing Committee amendments...excuse me, this amendment strikes the original Section 2 of the Standing Committee amendments, provides for the fees, or excuse me, provides this informa...

SENATOR LINDSAY: ...page 4, lines 12 through 20 of the Standing Committee amendments. So this amendment does not increase any fees. What it does is it leaves intact the language on page 4, lines 12 through 20 of the...your committee's amendments to LB 1092. That without...I guess what I am saying that with or without this amendment, that language would have remained in the amendment. At this time, Senator Conway, I know there is some confusion, and I hesitate to run this at eight o'clock at night if it is causing confusion, or if it is going to cause any problems. What I am going to do at this point is I am going to withdraw the amendment and offer it on Select File, don't want anybody to be blindsided or confused by the provisions of it. So at this time, I'd withdraw the amendment.

SENATOR CONWAY: We will appreciate your wisdom. We will go back to the...are there any other amendments? Mr. Clerk.
