CLERK: (Read LB 922 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been compiled with, the question is shall LB 922 pass? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam Chair, I would ask that we all check in and then I would ask for a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Would the senators please check in? Since we are at Final Reading the house is under call. Senator Ashford, Senator Chambers, Senator Cudaback, please check in. Senator Schrock, Senator Warner, and Senator Wesely, please check in. Would Senator Cudaback please check in. Speaker Baack.

SPEAKER BAACK: Madam President and colleagues, I would encourage any of my colleagues that are in the building to please come to the floor of the Legislature. We are trying to do Final Reading and there are only 33 people checked in. If we don't check in pretty soon I'll just read off the names of the people who are not here.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Speaker Baack. We have a request for a roll call vote on LB 922.

CLERK: (Roll Call vote taken. See pages 2000-01 of Legislative Journal.) 21 ayes, 7 nays, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 922 does not advance. Now proceed with Final Reading on LB 1178.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1178 on Final Reading.)
