Lamb's amendment to the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted. Before we proceed I would like to call the senators' attention to the south balcony. Special guests today of Senator Abboud are 49 fourth graders from Meadows Elementary in Omaha and their teachers. Would you please rise and be recognized. Welcome to the Chamber. Thank you. Does anyone wish to speak to the bill itself? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Wesely?

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Madam President. We didn't take a lot of time on this bill, but it's a very important bill, important to clarify a number of different problems and would ask for the vote to advance the bill now. Thank you very much.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. We'll now vote on the motion to advance LB 1019. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of the motion to advance LB 1019.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 1019 is advanced. LB 1019A.

CLERK: Madam President, 1019A is a bill by Senator Wesely to appropriate funds to implement LB 1019. I do have an amendment pending by Senator Wesely. (See AM4083 on page 2012 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, thank you. I have from the Fiscal Office an amendment that this is Cash Fund, and of course we increase fees in various areas to adequately cover this. There's a \$1,300 cost to carry out the provisions of Senator Withem's bill. So Senator Withem is costing us some money. We have to pay for it and would ask for adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Does anyone wish to address this amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Wesely? Closing is waived. We'll vote on the Wesely amendment to LB 1019A. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
