CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted. Does anyone wish to speak to the bill itself? Do you have closing, Senator Wesely?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Madam...Madam President, this is now about a \$9,000 bill, and it's all cash money, and it's more than that raised due to the fee increases under the bill. So I move for advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. We will now vote on the motion to advance LB 1019A. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 1019A.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 1019A is advanced. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, thank you. Enrollment and Review reports LB 1240 to Select File, E & R amendments, LB 1240A, LB 1059, all have E & R amendments attached; explanation of vote from Senator Wickersham; bills read on Final Reading have been presented to the Governor; a new resolution, LR 431, by Senator Landis, that'll be laid over and considered another time, Madam President. PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We'll now proceed with LB 1092.

CLERK: LB 1092, Madam President, was discussed yesterday by the Legislature. At that time, the committee amendments were offered by Senator Kristensen as Chair of the Transportation Committee. There was an amendment to those by Senator Robak that was adopted. When the Legislature adjourned, Senator Hall had pending an amendment to the committee amendments. Senator Hall, I understand you wish to withdraw the one you were offering last night, Senator, and offer a substitute amendment. Is that consistent with your...

SENATOR HALL: That's right, Mr. Clerk, if there's no objection.
