

how else it would make up that shortfall, if you don't make up that shortfall, it's going to become a matter for some deficit appropriation or, more likely, there will not be money spent on the cameras that there is needed in the counties for the operator's license issuances. And, as we talked about last night, and I reinforced it again this morning, those cameras are, I believe, it's their third extension of a contract. They are worn out. the contract is over. There is no way that those cameras will be used again. You either have to do away with having photos on the IDs and on the driver's and operator's license, or you have to buy a new system. And that system ends early in 1993. There is no way that we could enter into that contract next year if we don't...

PRESIDENT MOUL: One minute.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: ...do it this year. That's the purpose of the Department of Motor Vehicles coming in and needing some of these fee increases. And this is the second half. So I would urge that the Hall amendment be defeated to the committee amendments, unless, Senator Hall, if you can find another measure to replace that revenue or find another manner to do that, I suppose that would be a legitimate one to look at doing. I don't think it's unfair. The revocations are certainly the ones that are the tax and the drain upon the system, because of their driving habits, their driving performance, or their...just their manner of operation have caused a lot of problems in the system. That's the reason you have a reinstatement fee. If you have that reinstatement fee, because they haven't raised it in 12 years, now is an appropriate time to do that. And, quite frankly, \$100 to do that, some may argue that that's a penalty. I don't think that that's impos...intended to be a penalty, but..

PRESIDENT MOUL: Time.

SENATOR HALL: ...it is intended to cover the cost at least over the next period of years. Thank you.
