PRESIDENT MOUL: Would the senators all please check in. Senator Byars, Senator Pirsch, Senator Schmit, please check in. Senator Schrock and Senator Morrissey. We will proceed with roll call vote on the Hall amendment.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2015-16 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 17 nays, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The Hall amendment to the committee amendments is adopted. I will raise the call. Are there any further amendments to the committee amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, there are, Madam President. Madam President, the...Senator Ashford, I have a note, Senator, but I...Madam President, Senator Ashford had amendments printed.
