I don't see any funding in there though so I don't know where the funding is going to be coming from and that bothers me with the amendment, because I don't know how much funding we're talking about, whether it's going to be a small sum. It just said it shall be on a matching basis. But I would like to see some type of funding in there.

SENATOR ASHFORD: May I answer that, Senator Schellpeper?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yeah.

SENATOR ASHFORD: The funding is \$50,000 and that's in...that may be in AM3972, which...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Okay.

SENATOR ASHFORD: ...I may have inadvertently passed over and we'll have to get back to that.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Okay.

SENATOR ASHFORD: And I'll check with the Clerk.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Okay, that's what I was wondering because I didn't see any funding in this one so I was wondering where it was going to come from. But as long as the funding does not come out of the computer for the State Patrol I have no problem with the amendment. I think we need to have more gun education.
