

State Patrol computer fund, it's going to cost lot more than that to bring the records up to date to where they should be. And...but I think we also need gun education and so I would support the amendment as long as it doesn't come out, like I said, of the State Patrol funds. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Schellpeper. Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Madam President, I would challenge the germaneness of this particular amendment at this time.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Would you elaborate on your reasons for the challenge?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Madam President, it seems to me that...and not going to the merits, of course, of what Senator Ashford is speaking about, but the only connection here is that there are some fees to a computer fund that...where some of the fees in 1092 are going happen to go into a fund, as I read Senator Ashford's amendment it's going into the General Fund and it's really the fees...they're not in the subject...the same subject matter, I mean, aren't even close to it. At this point in time, this amendment, as we're getting towards the end of the session, there's going to be a temptation to put a lot of bills into the last remaining bills. And although Senator Ashford happens to be the one in here at the time doing that, I'm not reflecting on the policy, because the policy is probably very good but this particular debate is going to have the opportunity to go far afield with a lot of different subjects and in order to try to add some focus and control that we at least keep in the motor vehicle area, gun education is certainly not in the motor vehicle area and I don't see any conceivable connection here other than they both raise some money.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Ashford, would you respond?

SENATOR ASHFORD: Thank you, Madam President, and members, this amendment is the policy portion of the issue. The A bill has with it an appropriation that...of \$50,000. The way it is drafted now, it's an amendment to the A bill, the way it is drafted now and that was incorrect was as a General Fund appropriation. It is the intent, and certainly Senator Schellpeper and I, as we discussed it that the money for this
