a full discussion on the increases in your bill? Or are we missing the opportunity, if we do what you are wanting to do, are we going to miss the opportunity to fully discuss what are the increases of the bill and what impact that would have?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Well, I guess I am not suggesting that we suspend the rules and cease all debate. I guess what I was trying to do was to find a way to take the most objectionable or the things that would generate the most amount of discussion, take that off the platter for the moment, take the things that probably were less controversial. My attempt was not to stifle debate but to at least focus or limit the amount of controversy so that maybe we can give some other things the opportunity to be discussed. On Select File, I am going to file an amendment on Select File, so there will be some discussion on Select File of this bill. I don't...I mean it is up to whatever anybody wants to discuss. Certainly we are not going to limit their ability to say it, so I wouldn't suspend the rules to cease debate and those sort of things.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Okay, thank you. I will yield the rest of my time to Senator Chambers, if he would like it.
