rather than have the local taxpayers have to subsidize it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If there are benefits that farmers receive from the Department of Agriculture and other services provided by the University of Nebraska, and maybe the use of public lands, do you think those farmers should be the ones to pay the total cost of those benefits they receive, or should some of them, as they are now, be underwritten by the taxpayers at large?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: If they use the main service, then I think they should be the main ones that pay for it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So then we should take all of these services that go to benefit agriculture and require the farm community to pay the full cost of those services?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: If you can figure out how you are going to get it back, and how you are going to get the farmer to pay for it, and how much that they benefit, and how much benefits everybody else in the cities, I think it should be.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, you just tell them, this is the amount that you are going to pay, and if you don't, there is a lien against your property as with any other tax you don't pay. And then if you don't ante up eventually, we take it.

SPEAKER BAACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do you agree with that?

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: No.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Robak.

SENATOR ROBAK: Question.

SPEAKER BAACK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. We will now vote on ceasing debate. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on ceasing debate. Record, Mr. Clerk.
