SENATOR CHAMBERS: That is the one that I would withdraw.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn. Next amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lindsay, yours is a hold, right, Senator?

SENATOR LINDSAY: That's correct.

CLERK: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Withdraw.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Kristensen, you had that...do you want to still wait on yours?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: I would withdraw that.

CLERK: You want to withdraw, okay.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, I believe that is all that I have pending to the committee amendments at this time.

SPEAKER BAACK: We are now on the committee amendments. Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: I would like to move to divide the question on the committee amendments, and the division will take place on Sections 2 and 3 as one, and the rest of the bill with the exception of the Robak amendment, which was agreed to yesterday, which is separated from, but divide the question in that manner.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Bernard-Stevens, would you repeat that again so we have got the exact division.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Yeah, what I want to do on the committee amendments, as we have with the white copy, divided so that actually you have Sections 2 and 3 as one, which would, in essence, be LB 1092. The rest of the committee amendments as the second vote, which would be, in essence, LB 1095.
