He knows, and I've stated it before just this afternoon that I'm opposed to increases in these fees not only for the state side, but for the county side and I would fight to get them decreased, but since he wants a chance to move the bill, other people have bills behind this one that they want to move, I'm not going to fight this day to the end, but on Select File I will. But by the time this bill comes up on Select File, we may have reached some accords that will reduce considerably the amount of time that would have to be spent. I am asking that you vote to adopt this amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the closing on the Chambers amendment. We will now vote on that amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? We are voting on the Chambers amendment. Have you all voted? Again, this is an amendment to the amendment so it only takes a simple majority. Sometimes it takes more than once in this body. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment to the amendments is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to the first portion of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Anyone wishing to discuss this portion of the committee amendments? Seeing no one, Senator Kristensen, do you wish to close on this portion? Senator Kristensen waives closing. We will now vote on this portion of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the portion of the committee amendments all except for Sections 2 and 3. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the first portion of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: The first portion of the committee amendments is adopted. We will now go to the second portion which consists of Sections 2 and 3. Senator Kristensen, would you like to open?
