

Legislature, this second portion of the committee amendment is those county fees dealing with the issuance of original certificates of title, replacement, duplicate certificates of title, the refileing of a certificate of title and the noting of a lien onto a title as well as the additional dollar and a half of the registration certificate that is issued each time. Now that fee was the one that has been the subject of discussion this afternoon. Again, if you want to refer to page 3 of the committee statement it is those fees, five through nine, plus the paragraph right below that dealing with the additional dollar and a half each time that certificate is processed so it would be roughly a \$4.50 fee increase for each time one of those transactions takes place. With that, I'd urge the adoption of the committee amendments, the second half.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members, I also rise to support these amendments. I think we have pretty well discussed them all afternoon. We've been talking about them this morning and this afternoon. Even though we will be taking two separate votes, we have been discussing the whole issue and basically as Senator Kristensen has said, these are basically go to county except for the one, fifty cents of the registration that goes to the state patrol to upgrade their computer system to be used for crime checks across the whole state and that will bring Nebraska up to what most states have and it will just leave the State of North Dakota the only state rather than Nebraska and North Dakota. Right now we are the only two states that do not have our crime records on a computer and so this would help that. There are no large increases. Most of these you only, like the title, you only get once for each vehicle. It goes from six to ten. The lien goes from three to seven and the registration, that is a variable rate, but that will raise \$1.50. And so I support the committee amendments. Thank you.
