because most of the funding mechanisms of the bill were extracted from it, so I guess at this point in time I will withdraw this amendment, try and figure out just how much money remains in the bill, what possibly at least on the Appropriations Committee side of things in comparison to Transportation Committee side of things, how much money is there, what the priorities are, maybe come back with a recommendation on Select File. By withdrawing this amendment I want to point out that you've raised...there is still some fee increase in the bill and without my amendment you're not exactly spending it yet, but if you'd be prepared on Select File, it will be at least a recommendation on how to do that, whatever level you want the fees to be, what level you can arguably afford to spend. So at this time, for lack of a real understanding of where we are in this bill, I'll withdraw my amendment to the A bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.
