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SENATOR WEHRBEIN: It's about 5 or 6 million, around 6 million I think.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yet out of the 18 million?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, they haven't actually given any yet, but they have a commitment to do that if they come on production when they're supposed to late this summer.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Oh, okay. I agree with what you're doing just at the production credit.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR HARTNETT: How much is coming out of the cash trust fund right now and going into this fund, Senator Wehrbein? On '93-95 it's one cent. Is it no cents now or what is it?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: There is two cents I think up until, two cents credit given up until the end of this year.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Up to this year, then it will go down to one cent.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Right.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. Senator Lynch, you're next.

SENATOR LYNCH: Well, Mr. Speaker and members, I just want to point out I will support the amendment by Senator Wehrbein. What he is trying to accomplish is something what I discussed. But what it doesn't accomplish is what I had in my amendment and that was the precluding of using General Funds. Other than that, it was about the same and so I intend to support that. But there was a slight difference in it, Senator Wehrbein. Thanks.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Lynch. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, members, I wonder if Senator Wehrbein would yield to a question.
