SENATOR WESELY: (Laughter.)

SENATOR WESELY: All right. Well, I appreciate what Senator Wehrbein is trying to do with this amendment to protect the Highway Cash Fund, Trust Fund; but it does leave questions about how we do find the money. And I guess as we further debate it it would be worth discussing further.
