through the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund, shall not be funded through either Highway Cash Fund or the Highway Trust Fund. Several had raised this concern and this is simply really clarifying language. It is really in the bill, but this clarifies that it will not be. That's all this amendment does to the amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the closing on the amendment to the amendment by Senator Wehrbein. We will now vote on that amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Now we are on the portion of the amendments, all except for Section 10 as they have been amended. Is there discussion on that? Seeing none, Senator Wehrbein, did you wish to close on this section of the amendments?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I believe I will say very little. I think everybody has heard the debate and I just move its advancement on this section of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to adopt this section of the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of this portion of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: This portion of the amendment is adopted. I will raise the call, but I would encourage members to stay close to the Chamber. Now we will take up Section 10 of the amendments if I'm correct. Senator Wehrbein, would you like to open on Section 10?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, very briefly, this has to do with ETBE section. I would like to continue to keep this in here and I would call your attention to what Senator Haberman passed out. It's the back side of the issue, toward the end of the article, telling about the values of ETBE. I understand Senator Wesely's concern. Frankly, I won't live or die on this issue in this bill and I don't mind having it separated out. But I do think
