SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes.

CLERK: In that case, Mr. President, I have amendments to 3901 by Senator Hall. Senator Hall would move, Senator, I have your amendment number one, insert Section 14 from AM5258 into AM3901.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President, members. Could I ask the Clerk a question? I apologize, I wasn't present. Where do we stand at present? Where are we at with regard to the amendments that are in front of us?

CLERK: Well, the amendment that Senator...we've adopted the Enrollment and Review amendments which was a complete rewrite. Senator Kristensen has offered 3901 which is a rewrite of the bill. You are now proposing, Senator, 3901 would be a rewrite, you now have the first amendment to that.

SENATOR HALL: Okay, Senator Kristensen has opened on 3901?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR HALL: I apologize. Mr. President, I'll pull those amendments for right now.

SENATOR WARNER: Okay, we're discussing now then the amendment 3901. Senator Crosby, do you wish to speak?

SENATOR CROSBY: Yes, thank you, Mr. Chairman and members, I do want to speak. I'm going to speak now and then I won't speak anymore. I guess you'll all be happy to hear that. I always talk about the drunk driving bills, the DWI because I feel like it's my bill even though it is really Emil Beyer's bill and I thank him and I thank Senator Kristensen and all the people that have worked hard to try to bring us a compromise on Select File. For me there isn't any compromise, but we have to work these things in increments so we get to the point where we feel that maybe we have accomplished something that will help us in what I think is a problem in Nebraska, in every town, every city. The...I introduced a bill reducing the legal blood alcohol to .08 from .10 and Transportation did not put that bill out, but that's all right because a lot of the things that I think are very important are in both of these amendments that Senator Kristensen is bringing.
