

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But okay, then let me ask you, if the person refuses to give the drivers license to the officer, the person can then just say, I'm not going to give you my license, and the officer has to let the person go when it becomes clear that the person is not going to give the drivers license.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: And then...but they are also notified that then that 30 days starts to tick and that the license can be revoked.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But while they still have the drivers license in their possession they can continue to drive.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Well they can continue to drive, Senator, in any event. I mean that 30 day permit also allows them to drive. I mean it's not a restricted license in any manner.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So, what I'm getting to, there is no penalty if the person refuses to relinquish the license, is that true?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Well, other than they could be charged, I suppose, with refusing to obey a lawful order.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Where does it say that the officer shall order the person to relinquish the license?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: You're going to make me hunt for a little bit, but I'll find it for you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Or fish, if you prefer fishing to hunting. (Laugh.)

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: (Laugh.) I think we're going to have to get you a step stool so you can see over those books.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Laugh.) I can see what I need to see, I assure you.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Page 18, line 12, if the person has an operators license, the arresting officer shall take possession of the license and issue a temporary operators license valid for 30 days at that point.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And suppose the person doesn't give up the
