Speaking from a scientific level, now he's...he and I can exchange letters, I can bring in depositions, if you want, he and I were talking about that, from different experts saying, yes, it is, no, it's not. And I'm talking about reliable experts, experts in Omaha, experts in Lincoln, experts wherever you're going to have a trial. You know we're going to have those experts saying both ways, whether it is or whether it isn't. But we're making a choice here that we're never going to hear from those experts. No defendant in the State of Nebraska will ever have a right to use those experts, because we here in
