for amendments, I need to know that. I am going to look very carefully at what amendments are being filed on bills that are being returned from Final Reading. If you're trying to amend other bills into those, those are going to fall at the bottom of the list, they're not going to be at the top of the list. If there are amendments that are needed for that piece of legislation, then those will come at the top of the list, not amending other bills into bills on Final Reading. On Thursday we will...we will begin at 9:00 a.m. We will have the regular lunch break. We'll work until approximately 7:00 p.m. By that point we're going to have to have all of the bills up to the bill drafters office so they can get all of those correctly engrossed. And while we're waiting for those to be correctly engrossed, we will be in Final Reading. We'll do a bunch of bills on Final Reading until all the legislation comes down to us, Wednesday night, or Thursday night before we adjourn. And then next Monday and Tuesday we'll be doing some Final Reading, veto overrides, some various odds and ends like that, whatever resolutions that we have still pending before the Legislature at that point. I think that that's what we're going to do for the next few days. Oh, also tomorrow we will be talking...there is a possibility we'll have some time in the afternoon where there are some bills that are clean that are on Select File. We'll just take a block of time and we'll move those bills on to Final Reading so that we can allow the bill drafters office some time to work on some of those bills that are already cleaned up. So, if you have some bills that are candidates for that, that have no amendments pending on them on Select File, please let me know right away tomorrow morning, and we'll have a block of time to move some of those bills up to the bill drafters office. I think that will take care of it. Thank you.
