SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Hillman. We will now vote on LR 429. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of LR 429.

SPEAKER BAACK: LR 429 is adopted. We'll go to Item 6 on the agenda and LB 1184A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 1184A was introduced by Senator Rasmussen. (Read title.) I do have an amendment to the bill by Senator Rasmussen.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Rasmussen.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, the amendment strikes the original A bill which was some funding that might have needed to be there for a possible amendment that may be coming on on Select File. But, in discussing it, we determined that that was not needed. However, there is a need for some funding in relationship to the bill itself. I would ask that you would move this over at this time and that we could discuss it more in detail in the context of the discussion on LB 1184 on Select File. I would be glad to answer any questions. If not, I would move the amendment to the A bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: On the amendment, Senator Bernard-Stevens.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Just a comment and, Senator Rasmussen, you can respond if you feel you need to. On General File, not on the A bill particularly but on LB 1184 there are a series of questions that people had and prior to General File there was an attempt at least to try to bring some people together to answer some of those questions. Those questions were brought up on General File. To my knowledge, there has still not been any meeting or merging of people to try to answer those questions so I'm hoping that when we get to LB 1184 maybe during the meantime
