Otherwise, I and others may...which may not make any difference at all, there's probably 42 votes there for it anyway, but we'll have some difficulty in advancing if some of the questions cannot at least be attempted to be answered. So I do say that I'm hoping between now and when we get to it on Select File there should be some time that either your staff and mine can get together or you and I can get together or something to get those questions that were raised on General File answered.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Any other discussion? Senator Rasmussen, did you wish to close?

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: Yes, Mr. Speaker, I wanted to respond to Senator Bernard-Stevens. I don't know what happened here but we did have a meeting and you were supposed to have been invited and, obviously, it did not happen and I apologize for that. But I will update you on what has happened at that meeting. There was a rather large group of people who came together who did have concerns about this bill and I will be more than happy to share that with you and if we need to, to have further discussion before we get to the full debate on this bill. With that, I would just urge you to vote for this amendment into the A bill for LB 1184. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Rasmussen. We will now vote on the amendment offered by Senator Rasmussen. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Rasmussen's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. We are now on the bill as amended. Is there any discussion?

CLERK: Senator, I have your motion to withdraw the bill. I assume that's to be withdrawn.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: We are now on the advancement of LB 1184A. Is there any discussion? Seeing none, Senator Rasmussen, would you
