that reconsideration motion on the agenda. That possibility lies out there. I think, based on the comments that I've heard, that this proposal would have been shot down anyway. It could have been done if it had been taken up the first day it was available to be taken up because it doesn't appear that there are the 25 votes to reconsider, let alone the 30 to overrule the agenda. That is not necessarily the point that I am trying to make. The point I'm trying to make I think lies a little to the east of this Chamber. With that, Mr. President, I don't want to set a precedent here. I don't want the ability with regard...because I don't think we've resolved the reconsideration issue and there clearly aren't the votes here for this issue in terms of overruling the agenda. I'm not going to ask people to put their votes on the line at this point because I don't think the issue is going to be a straight-up vote on the merits or demerits of LB 72. And, with that, after taking a little more than 35 minutes is all, and I ask that we try to keep it to a half an hour. I'm going to withdraw my motion to overrule the agenda.

SENATOR CONWAY: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I may, some items for the record. I have amendments to LB 1001 by Senator Landis. (Re: AM4135. Filed in the Clerk's office.) And, Mr. President, new resolution, LR 436, by the Ag Committee. (Read brief description. See pages 2114-15 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Legislative Bill LB 958, I believe, is the next bill scheduled for consideration. Senator Will, I have enrollment and review amendments pending first of all, Senator. (See AM5272 as found on page 1471 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CONWAY: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. President, excuse me, Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 958.

SENATOR CONWAY: You heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They're adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have, or the first amendment is by Senator Moore. Senator, AM3542 I have a note you wish to withdraw and substitute 3598.
