ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate.

SENATOR WARNER: Debate...motion's carried. Debate is ceased. Motion is the adoption of the Moore amendment, but the house is under call. Members, continue to check and return to the Chamber. Yeah, Senator Lowell, you want to check in, please. Senator Haberman,...

SENATOR MOORE: Can I begin (inaudible) my closing?

SENATOR WARNER: ...check in, please. Yeah, Senator Moore, you may proceed to close as we wait for members to come in, please.

SENATOR MOORE: Thank you, Senator Warner, members of the body. I once again apologize for the length of this discussion. As I mentioned in the beginning, I had hoped we could have a...I mean, there's good reasons to vote for my amendment and good reasons to vote against it and I can live with that and the only time I spoke really on the amendment other than my opening was to, one, point out the absurdity of some of the arguments on the germaneness rule and, second, to defend myself when a few members challenged what I said and trying to accuse me of misleading the body. And I...if I, like I said, the only confusing...the people trying to confuse us, who had me confused because they...I made the mistake of maybe passing out to the body what the bill did and the repealer clause. Nothing sinister about that. That is common practice. That's what we do all the time. Nothing unusual about that at all. What my amendment does is makes some very small changes in our existing helmet law regarding chin straps. It makes the fines mirror those of the seat belt law. It does, in effect, marry the two together. If there is a petition process, the two would be wed together, as I was always convinced they should be, and I don't have a problem with that. As I said in the beginning, that's what my...my intent is to simply make some small changes. Some things may happen, and I told you in the beginning, as far as a petition process, how it would come into being. And so if I could exercise only the people who challenge my credibility on
