SPEAKER BAACK: We are asking a request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The house is under call. All members please report to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Members, please report to the Chamber and record your presence. Senator Hillman, would you record your presence, please. The house is under call. Members, please report to the Chamber and record your presence. The house is under call. Looking for Senator Rogers, Senator Cudaback, Senator Haberman, Senator Schmit. All members are now present. We are voting on the Chambers amendment. We will have a roll call vote. Members, please hold your conversations down. It is very difficult for the Clerk to hear the responses. As he gets older, his hearing gets a little weaker. Roll call vote, Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote. See page 2124 of the Legislative Journal.) 18 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: This portion of the amendment fails. We will now take up the second portion of the amendment. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, Mr. Speaker, Senator Nelson was concerned about how slowly things are moving, I'm sure everybody is and I indicated that if she would vote for that amendment, I would have no more to offer. Senator Nelson kept her portion of the agreement. I will keep mine, but this I must say. Then I'm not going to say any more on your attempt to advance the bill but I'll vote against it and I want to be sure we have a machine vote because I want a record. I think this bill is chock full of hypocrisy. I think there has been great dishonesty on the part of many people on the floor, not because you didn't support my amendment, but I was really trying to get us on record to see if we really want a safety consideration or not and it's obvious that we don't. And with that, Mr. Speaker, I'm going to withdraw that amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn. The call is raised.
