with Senator Beutler relative to the way the bill is structured, I had combined 20 and 21 as one division. His preference is that those not be addressed together and so I would suggest an adjustment to that request where Section 20 would be the sixth division and allow Section 21 to be dealt with all the remaining funding sections and the like, so the first one, two, three, four, five are as I originally described them. The sixth division would be only Section 20 and then 21 and the balance of the bill would be the seventh division.

SENATOR LAMB: Senator Beutler. This is on the first division, I believe.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Lamb, I would move to adjourn so we can get the procedure straightened out here.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. Clerk, do you have anything to read into the record?

CLERK: Nothing to read in, Mr. President.

SENATOR LAMB: The motion is to adjourn. A machine vote has been requested. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 11 nays to adjourn, Mr. President.

SENATOR LAMB: We are adjourned until nine o'clock tomorrow morning.
