SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members, starting Monday this week has kicked off the Week of the Young Child. That's a week that we spend focusing in on and celebrating the children in our state and our nation. Would ask for recognition by the Legislature this week on behalf of the children of Nebraska.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the resolution offered by Senator Wesely? Senator Abboud. No. Seeing none, we will now vote on the resolution. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of LR 430.

SPEAKER BAACK: LR 430 is adopted. We will now proceed to Item 6, LB 1063A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 1063A is on Select File. No E & Rs. I do have an amendment to the bill, however, from Senators Warner and Hall. The amendment is found on page 2089 of the Journal.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this is an amendment which reflected the amendments that Senator Hall had added, the Legislature adopted on LB 719A which one part of it dealt with a study for the economic tax...a study of the impact by economic sector of the Nebraska tax system which had a request for seventy-four thousand, as I recall, five hundred dollars. In order to fund that there was left over from a study that was conducted last year, rather approved last year that was...we had a \$50,000 appropriation to the Legislative Council for that same project. The initial expenditures from that was a little over 5,000 so we would be deleting \$44,200 from the Legislative Council program, which is the money left over from the initial part of the study, and have that redirected to the Department of Revenue to complete that. And then the other portion is to fund the other amendment and I can't...it doesn't...I'm sorry to say I can't recall specifically at the moment what it is. But, in any event, it is the request for the expenditure for those amendments that Senator Hall put on LB 719A. I would move their adoption.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore, did you wish to address this amendment?
