The only comment I will make at this point, and then I will turn my light on again is that with the defeat of Senator Hall's amendment much that is going to be talked about and perhaps even passed with reference to health care and health care costs is not going to have any real significance because we let the elephant go. Now we are dealing with the little gnat that is on the ear of the elephant that the elephant could just flick off if he chooses, but since this will entertain us and distract us from the real business, these little gnats will be allowed to go through.
