SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: Good afternoon. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Roll call. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Do you have any items for the record?

CLERK: Just that LR 430 is now ready for your signature, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 430. Mr. Clerk, we're on LB 835A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 835A was discussed last night by the Legislature. At that time, Enrollment and Review amendments were adopted. Senator Beutler offered AM4295 that the body concluded was germane to the bill, after a germaneness question. Senator Conway had requested a division, Mr. President. I believe that's where the Legislature adjourned.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, as I understand the process and the point at where we are now, the question has been divided and that's where we stopped. And, at this point, I would challenge the ruling of the Chair as to the division of the question, and in that respect ask that the Chair be overruled and I would like to speak to that, if appropriate, at the appropriate time.

SPEAKER BAACK: I think your motion is in order. One second. Senator Beutler, I will let you open on this and then...and then as the rules are people may speak only once on this motion to overrule the Chair. Senator Beutler, you may open.
