SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Beutler, would you respond, please.

SENATOR MOORE: Do you have an amendment...do you have an amendment to appropriate the money in this bill? Do you have that amendment filed?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes, should be attached to it.

SENATOR MOORE: Is that...that's a separate amendment you're going to allow after your stopper motion?

SENATOR BEUTLER: No.

SENATOR MOORE: It's not in the...it's not in the amendment as it's now filed. There's no provision to appropriate the money. All it does is go to the fund. There's no provision to appropriate the money. Is there an amendment filed to do that?

SENATOR BEUTLER: There's not a separate amendment, Senator Moore. It should be in the main amendment.

SENATOR MOORE: Well, one, there's a question on whether we can do that because of an appropriation in the A bill and the bill is probably drafted correctly now because there is no appropriation in it. You're going to have to file something to appropriate the money and if you follow the Attorney General's Opinion from last week consistently saying you can't do that, you can't do that either, because the games you're trying to play trying to amend something in an A bill you're just opening up a whole new can of worms on levels of impossibility we're trying to throw down. You've got to remember our germaneness rule is there to try and protect the body from screwing up the constitutional provision against two subjects, that's why it's there. That's why, in all likelihood, there is a concern about having an appropriation in this bill because what you should have is whatever the bill number was and it's A bill appropriating the money. That's what you have to do and you have to file an amendment to do that. And so the system is so screwed up, even somebody like me, who has not followed every rule in my lifetime, is amazed by this.
