CLERK: 27 ayes, 10 nays to cease debate.

SPEAKER BAACK: Debate has ceased. Senator Moore, do you want to close?

SENATOR MOORE: Mr. Speaker, I would yield my time to Senator Beutler.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I think we have come to the end of the trail on this particular bill. And I regret that that's the case because there were an awful lot of people in this Legislature, in fact, I believe a majority of this Legislature who believed that the program...the package of programs presented in this legislation and the means of financing included in the legislation altogether would have been appropriate and of benefit to the people of the State of Nebraska. But the fact of the matter is we are trapped. We have done, I think, everything that we could do and stretch things and have received indulgences from this body in attempting it and I appreciate that. This bill will be back first thing next year but, for right now, I think that the only reasonable thing to do is to ask unanimous consent to bracket the bill to the 15th of April.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there any objection? It is bracketed. I will raise the call. We are going to pass over 556 for the present time and go to LB 1257.

CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to 1257, Senator Will, I have Enrollment and Review amendments pending, Senator. Senator Will, the E & R amendments, Senator.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 1257.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendment to LB 1257. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Rod Johnson, AM3892, Senator, I have a note that you wanted to withdraw.
