SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Morrissey. You don't need...Okay. I have nothing further pending on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Morrissey, do you wish to make the motion to advance?

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Move to advance LB 1257.
