

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes, Senator Kristensen, members of the Legislature, this is to simply put the A bill, for the Clean Air Act, into the A bill for 1257, so that they are all together. As was indicated earlier in the discussion, it's in the amount of about \$300,000 for the next fiscal year, and \$465,000 for FY '93-94, and thereafter it will be funded by emission fees. But these General Fund fees are for the setting up of the program. Ask for the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Morrissey. Senator Morrissey waives off. Any other people wish to discuss this amendment? Seeing none, Senator Beutler, would you like to close? Senator Beutler waives closing. All in favor say aye...or all opposed. Excuse me. All in favor...Machine vote. We are voting on the Beutler amendment. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? We are voting on the Beutler amendment to LB 1257A. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Bohlke would move to amend, Mr. President. Page 2059 of the Journal.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Mr. President,...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Mr. President, members, this strictly allows for the transfer of funds and the hiring of the position rather than it being a consultant.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Is there anyone wishing to discuss the Bohlke amendment? Seeing none, Senator, would you like to close? Senator Bohlke closes. We will be voting on the Bohlke amendment. All in favor vote aye. Excuse me. Senator Beutler, did not see your...
