SPEAKER BAACK: One corporation could contribute all 750,000.

SENATOR ABBOD: And same with the PAC?

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes.

SENATOR ABBOD: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Senator Abboud. Is there anyone else who wishes to speak to the Baack amendment? Seeing none, Senator Baack, would you like to close? Senator Baack waives closing. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Baack's amendment.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you. The amendment is adopted. Anything else?

CLERK: Senator Wesely would move to amend, AM4165, Senator.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Please withdraw that.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: It is withdrawn.
