SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members. Senator Hartnett, would you respond to a question, please?

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Hartnett, does the AM4267 version what would become LB 1240 contain anything as it related...as the original LB 1240 did to credits, enhanced credits under LB 270 passed in 1987?

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yes, um-hmm.

SENATOR HALL: Okay, thank you very much. I rise to support the amendment. I believe that the narrowing of the focus, the limitations that it puts in place actually makes 1240 a much better bill and I would urge the members to adopt the Hartnett amendment.
