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is, and there is, in my judgment, there is no way we can do an income tax amendment in twenty minutes because I have to stick to the time frame, and I think there are a couple of other bills that are important, judicial redistricting and a couple of other things that can be accomplished in this twenty minutes, and, in my judgment, that is the best for the process of the Legislature.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, I'd ask to, I assume, is it to overrule the Chair's decision that this is not in order, would that be an appropriate motion to make at this time?

SPEAKER BAACK: I think that the Clerk advises me, and I think he is absolutely correct, you would have to overrule the agenda. Not simply overrule the Chair, you would have to overrule the agenda.

SENATOR LANDIS: I understand. In that case, I will make that motion. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: You may speak to that motion.

SENATOR LANDIS: And I will do it as briefly as I can. I don't...I understand the need to get twenty minutes for other bills, and I will be happy to observe that. The income tax issue comes down to three basic concerns of an amendment that I can briefly describe; potentially an amendment offered by Senator Warner, although he may not push that in the event we have a limited period of time, and I think one viable amendment offered by Senator Hall. The debate, if kept succinct, can be done in 45 minutes, maximum of an hour, and although I know that the Speaker wants to stop at six-thirty and change, if he can adjust that to seven-thirty, a time that we have done a good deal for the rest of the session and in recent days, we can attend to a measure that changes 450,000 taxpayer returns to reduce their burden. That is a fair goal to reach. It is achievable in about an hour's time, if we will overrule the agenda.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Landis, if I may comment, I simply cannot move that deadline, because if we move that deadline, that may mean that we are not going to get the...that we are probably not going to get the bill back anyway. The bill would not be returned to us by midnight. So we wouldn't have the bill back from E & R by that point. I have been in touch with E & R
