SENATOR CONWAY: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, anything else on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CONWAY: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Move the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR CONWAY: There are no lights. The motion is to advance LB 1059. All in favor signify by saying aye, opposed. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 672 is the next bill as I understand it pursuant to the Speaker's direction. Enrollment and Review amendments first.

SENATOR CONWAY: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 672.

SENATOR CONWAY: You've heard the motion. All in favor signify by saying aye, opposed. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Nelson would move to amend the bill, AM4294, Senator.

SENATOR NELSON: Mr. Speaker, you will really hear me rattle this one off. You'll think I'm reading a bill off. This is amendment 4294 which is to LB 692 (sic), and this incorporates five bills. They are clean bills as far as I know. They have, there are no problems with any of them. The first bill is Senator Warner's LB 1208, they all have to do with retirement, provides that when two or three or more counties go together for cooperative extension programs that they can put their budgets together and it also refers to retirement issues that need to be
